Local Rule 2.1.1 Foreclosure Mediation**

ORDER

WHEREAS, the Circuit Courts for Waukesha County, under the authority of Wis. Stat. §753.35 (1) adopted Waukesha County Civil Division Local Rules 2.1.1 on June 9, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge of the Third Judicial Administrative District, under Wis. Stat. §753.35 (1), (2) and SCR 70.21(15e) has the authority to approve local circuit court rules; now

IT IS ORDERED that Waukesha County Civil Division Local Rule 2.1.1 is created to read as follows:

2.1.1 FILING OF PLEADINGS -FORECLOSURE MEDIATION ALTERNATIVES:

(a) In all residential foreclosure actions, the plaintiff shall attach to the summons and complaint the following forms:


- 1) Notice of Availability of Mediation; and**
- 2) Mediation Request Form**

(b) Each form shall be served on all defendants named in the action. Both forms shall be produced on goldenrod paper and shall be made available through the Waukesha County Clerk of Court's office.

"Residential foreclosure actions" is defined as those foreclosure actions involving owner occupied-one to four family residences.
