

**IN THE MATTER OF:
REASSIGNING CASELOAD DUE TO
THE ROTATION OF JUDICIAL
ASSIGNMENTS IN WAUKESHA
COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT****ORDER**

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Supreme Court, pursuant to Article VII, Section 4 (3) of the Wisconsin Constitution, in exercising its administrative authority over the judicial system, has adopted Supreme Court Rule 70.23(3), which requires the Chief Judge of every Judicial Administrative District to design a plan for rotation of judicial assignments and file that plan with the Chief Justice or his/her designee for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge of the Third Judicial Administrative District finds it in the best interest of judicial administration to rotate and reassign the caseloads of the following judges;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that, effective August 3, 2009:

1. All family cases previously assigned to the Honorable Donald J. Hassin, Jr., Circuit Court Branch 9, including specific assignments, be reassigned to the Honorable Kathryn W. Foster, Circuit Court Judge, Branch 12 in courtroom 162.
2. All civil cases previously assigned to the Honorable Kathryn W. Foster, Circuit Court Judge, Branch 12, including specific assignments, be reassigned to the Honorable Donald J. Hassin, Jr., Circuit Court Branch 9 in courtroom 187.
3. All family cases previously assigned to the Honorable James R. Kieffer, Circuit Court Judge, Branch 8, including specific assignments, be reassigned to the Honorable Lee S. Dreyfus, Jr., Circuit Court Branch 5 in courtroom 370.
4. All criminal cases previously assigned to the Honorable Lee S. Dreyfus, Jr., Circuit Court Judge, Branch 5, including specific assignments, be reassigned to the Honorable James R. Kieffer, Circuit Court Branch 8 in courtroom 187.
